New this year: on Capitol Hill Day all delegates will be issued a CWF Polo to be worn with Khaki pants or skirt. No Capri/cropped pants on this day.



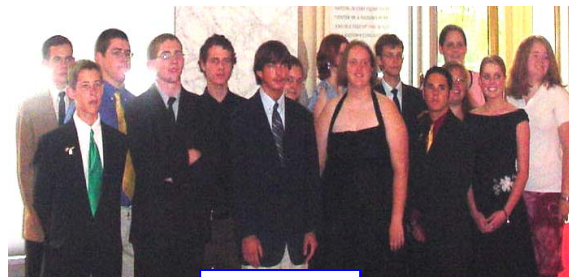

Why a Dress Code?

Throughout the CWF program, participants will meet many people. Each delegate represents not only him or herself, but their family, county, state and 4-H. Clothing and grooming reflect upon the participants and what they represent. Therefore a dress code has been developed which describes the type of dress expected for each CWF activity. The dress code applies to both youth and adult participants. **It is the responsibility of each delegate to adhere to this code and the responsibility of each adult to uphold and enforce this code.**

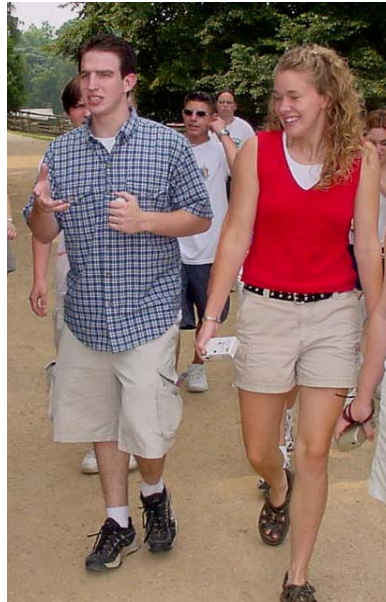
Standard Dress Code

- Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be a respectable length. (Being as long as the individual's fingers when arms are fully extended at their side)
- Tube top/strapless shirts will not be allowed during CWF.
- Spaghetti strap clothing will not be allowed unless it is in the form of evening wear (cultural heritage only).
- Tank-Top/Sleeveless shirts must have straps wider than two fingers.
- Cropped shirts and extreme low-rise pants are not allowed.
- Ripped clothing, cut-off shorts, T-shirts with offensive slogans or messages that are in bad taste, muscle shirts, and similar items are not allowed.
- No hats may be worn inside Conference Center buildings.
- Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times.
- Please keep all clothing in good taste.

The agents who are attending CWF will use their best judgment concerning clothing issues. They will make the call as to whether an outfit or article of clothing is inappropriate.
